Important Information For Educational Planning

- Successful completion of ENG 91 or equivalent placement.
- This occupation requires the ability to lift 50 pounds and be able to work on your feet for up to 8 hours.
- Students must be able to meet the physical requirements to be assigned to a clinical rotation and meet employment demands
- To participate in the clinical aspect of the program, student must receive a “No Record on File” report from the Washington State Patrol related to Crimes Against Persons (there are some exceptions, contact instructor for details).
- Students must have current immunizations or laboratory verification of immune status. This could include, but not limited to Hepatitis B series, Tetanus/Diphtheria, 2-step Tuberculosis Test, Measles/Mumps/Rubella, Varicella, and seasonal flu shot as required by contracts with clinical facilities. Proof of immunity is required by the last week of the first term to participate in the clinical portion of the program.
- Must have high school diploma or equivalent
- Must complete CPR for Healthcare Professionals (Adult, Child, Infant, and AED prior to last week of the first term
- Basic computer skills recommended.
- **Program Starts:** Fall and Spring Terms.
- **Program class times:** First term: Mon-Thurs 9am-1:30pm; Second term: Mon-Fri 9am-1:30pm. Extra day on second term.
