## Important Information For Educational Planning

- Apply for Certificate after completing 105,107, and 120.
- Apply for Certificate after completing 105,107,120, 115, and elective.
- Apply for State Credential when all classes listed are complete.
- To become a licensed childcare provider in Washington State, you must participate in a Department of Early Learning (DEL) licensing orientation and apply for and receive licensure. State law requires DEL to run background checks on anyone who is authorized to care for or who has unsupervised access to children in licensed childcare facilities.
- Proficiency in reading, writing, and understanding of the English language is required. Students are required to take a placement assessment or equivalent before entry into the program.
- Successful completion of ENG 091 or equivalent before program classes.
