### Important Information For Educational Planning

#### **Prerequisites:**

- High school diploma or high school equivalency diploma
- All General Education and MLT courses must be completed with a minimum grade of a "C"
- Speaking, understanding, and writing the English language is required.
- To enter the program, a student must meet the perquisites for college-level reading, writing and math.
- To participate in the clinical aspect of the program students must receive a "No Record on File" report from the Washington State Patrol, related to Crimes Against Persons and have current immunizations or laboratory verification of immune status. This could include, by not limited to Hepatitis B series, Tetanus/Diphtheria, Tuberculosis Test, Measles/Mumps/Rubella, Covid vaccination, and Varicella as required by contracts with clinical facilities and CDC recommendations. Proof of immunizations is required by the first day of class in summer term, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- CPR certification from the American Health Association with the designation Health Care Provider is required prior to commencing clinical rotation.

### **Physical Requirements:**

- Students must be able to safely lift and carry objects up to 40 pounds and stand for long periods of time.
