Important Information For Educational Planning

Prerequisites:

- Before starting the program, students must have a high school diploma or high school equivalency diploma.
- To participate in the clinical aspect of the program, student must receive a "No Record on File" report from the Washington State Patrol, related to Crimes Against Persons.
- Obtain CPR certification
- Students must have current immunizations or laboratory verification of immune status. This could include, but not limited to Hepatitis series, **Full COVID vaccination**, Tetanus/Diphtheria, Tuberculosis Test, Measles/Mumps/Rubella and Varicella as required by contracts with clinical facilities and CDC recommendations.
- Proof of immunizations is required by the last day of **FALL TERM WITHOUT EXCEPTION.**
- **ALL general education courses (Biology and Chemistry must be taken within the past 5 years) need to be taken (with a minimum of a "B") prior to the Fall term when the HISTO courses begin.**
- **Program Starts:** Fall term
- **Program class times:** 7am-3pm Tuesday through Friday. The exact schedule will vary by term, some courses are online and or hybrid (a combination of face-to-face and online learning).
