<p>* Prerequisites:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Before starting the program, students must have a high school diploma or high school equivalency diploma. * In order to participate in the clinical aspect of the program students must receive a "No Record on File" report from the Washington State Patrol, related to Crimes Against Persons. * Obtain CPR certification. * Students must have current immunizations or laboratory verification of immune status. This could include, but not limited to, Hepatitis series, Tetanus/Diphtheria, Tuberculosis Test, Measles/Mumps/Rebella and Varicella as required by contracts with clinical facilities and CDC recommendations. * Proof of immunizations is required by the last day of class FALL QUARTER without exception. <p>*All general education courses (Biology and Chemistry must be taken within the past 5 years) need to be taken (with a minimum of a "B") prior to the Fall quarter when the HISTO courses begin.</p>
