Important Information

Prerequisites:

- Must have a high school diploma or high school equivalency per governing body (AST) to participate in the clinical aspect of the program, students must pass multiple background checks. Students must have current American Heart Association CPR for the Healthcare Provider and immunizations or laboratory verification of immune status.
- Immunizations include, but not limited to: Hepatitis B series, Tetanus/Diphtheria, Tuberculosis Test, Measles/Mumps/Rubella, and Varicella, as required by contract with clinical facilities and CDC recommendations. Proof of immunizations and CPR should be completed by the first day of class of the third term of the SURG courses. No student will be allowed at a clinical site without completion of immunizations.
- This occupation requires the ability to stand, sit and walk for extended periods of time and to lift and hold 50 pounds. Student must be able to meet these physical requirements to complete lab requirements, be assigned to clinical rotation, and get a job in this field.
- A physical is required for each student prior to clinical rotation. Must be at least 18 years in age by the time clinical experienced starts, usually in September to April.
- **Students must maintain a "B" or better in all prerequisites, general education and Core Allied Health courses to start the SURG courses.**
